

The **Applied Learning Tracker** (<u>www.altracker.co.uk</u>) is the simple-to-use, powerful online student tracking system designed to help institutions monitor the progress of students on a variety of applied learning courses, including BTECs and OCRs. It has been developed and refined since 2010 in collaboration with leading providers of applied provision.

The system provides a series of visual, colour-coded reports to help identify whether or not students are on course to meet targets, and which areas of the course may be causing difficulties. **Unit Overviews** provide a summary of each individual unit to allow identification of particular areas of concern. In this example, the M2 grade is causing difficulty for most of the class – hovering over the heading provides the description of the grading criteria. Also, the red colours in Joanne's row suggest she is falling behind and may need extra support.
